- Advanced chronic or serious life-threatening illness
- Risk of death within one year
- Incurable cancer
- Organ system failure
- Severe progressive neurological disease

Description


- Assist with patient care needs
- Establish goals of care
- Discuss and develop Advanced Directives
- Provide family education and support through decision making and symptom management


Highmark Goal

 Greater than or equal to 11% of BCBS patients discharged will have palliative care assessment

Goal was not initially met.

A nurse practitioner was hired as a provider who could assess this patient population.

At time of assessment, the provider would determine if the patient was a good candidate for continued palliative care

Obstacles

 Identifying qualifying patients on admission.

Intervention

 IT department developed a daily report that provides each patient admitted in the last 24 hours, that met our diagnosis criteria (Identified with ICD-10 codes)

Results

- Percentage of patients assessed increased to >60%
- By implementing this program, CHH has successfully met the criteria yielding and extra \$300,000 in reimbursement
- Enabled an additional NP and Palliative physician to be added inpatient as well as opening an outpatient clinic in the hospitals comprehensive cancer center.
