Home-Based palliative care (HBPC): the future of quality medical care for the sickest and most complex patients.

→ Yet, it is not reliably available



Preliminary Results as of June 2018: Mapping Community Palliative Care

- → 507 palliative care programs serving the community have participated since August 2017
- → These programs serve 1,274 sites in the community:



- Operational, financial, educational and regulatory structures needed to support HBPC






